TUITION AND FEES SCHEDULE

2020–2021 School Year

REGISTRATION FEE:

This year's registration fee schedule is as follows:

- February (current family) \$50 per child (*discounted*)
- March (open enrollment) \$50 per child (*discounted*)
- April \$100 per child (*discounted*)
- May (and thereafter) \$150 per child (*regular fee*)

SCHOLARSHIPS: (There is approximately \$65,000 available in scholarships.)

The following list of scholarships are available for application to qualifying families:

- Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program (EITC)
- Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit Program (OSTC)
- Central PA Scholarship Fund (CPSF)
- Community Foundation Scholarship

More information about each scholarship and application deadlines can be found on the school website.

BOOKS AND FEES LIST:

Books and Fees lists will be posted on Sycamore for each child in June. The school office will let parents know via email when this has been uploaded to Sycamore. These fees are based on the books/items used in each grade and are detailed separately per student.

On the Books and Fees list, parents must mark off any books that will not be needed. The completed Book and Fees list **MUST BE** signed by every family for every student, and returned to the school office by **July 17**. If parents wish to pay Books and Fees in full, it is due one week before school begins.

Anyone who turns in the Book and Fees list after July 17 will automatically be assessed the entire book fee which cannot be refunded.



FUNDRAISING FEE:

Fundraising participation at HBA is mandatory for each family. The fundraising fee is \$250. This fee is refundable to a family’s account who chooses to complete the requirements for Serv-A-Thon (the school’s fundraising program). The fee will be assessed to you based on the payment option you choose. See the attached Serv-A-Thon information sheet for more details. Families who enroll after the Servathon program has concluded are not eligible for the refund.

TUITION:

K3/K-4

KINDERGARTEN:

A child must be 5 years old by September 30 to enroll in the K-5 program at Harvest Baptist Academy. The Kindergarten program is set up according to the following enrollment options:

K-5 FULL WEEK (Monday through Friday)

All Day Non-HBC Tithing

\$3,200 annually

All Day HBC Tithing

\$2,750 annually

Morning Only Non-HBC Tithing

\$2,100 annually

Morning Only HBC Tithing

\$1,750 annually

**Scheduled days for partial week enrollment cannot be changed. If a family desires an alternate partial week schedule, they may opt for a full week schedule and tailor the schedule as is permissible. However, the full week tuition will be assessed.*

1ST-12TH GRADE:

Non-HBC Tithing

First child: \$3,200 annually

Second child: \$3,000 annually

Third child: \$2,800 annually

Fourth child: No additional tuition

HBC Tithing

First child: \$2,750 annually

Second child: \$2,550 annually

Third child: \$2,350 annually

Fourth child: No additional tuition

**Graduated discounts apply to K-5 all-day students also, if applicable.*

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Tuition can be paid in the following ways:

Payment can be sent to the school with your child, mailed to the school office, dropped off in the school office, or paid online (tuition invoices will be sent via email).

If payments are late, the school reserves the right to issue a late fee. If an account becomes delinquent, the school reserves the right to financially withdraw any student(s) until outstanding payment has been made.

ADDITIONAL FEES:

The following possible fees will be detailed separately by student, according to his grade level, classes, and participation.

- Sports Fee (invoiced when participation is validated for each sport season)
- Extra-Curricular Fee (Field Trips, etc.)
- Kindergarten Graduation Fee
- Senior Graduation Fee
- Standardized Testing Fee

These fees will be invoiced to each family at the applicable times within the school year; please do not pay in advance. They are non-refundable.
